
Samhi Hotels re-files IPO papers with Sebi; looks to raise INR 1,000 cr via fresh issue

Goldman Sachs-backed Samhi Hotels has refilled its draft prospectus for an initial public offering (IPO). The IPO comprises a fresh issue of equity shares worth INR 1,000 crore and an offer-for-sale (OFS) of 90 lakh equity shares by existing shareholders, according to the draft red herring prospectus (DRHP).

Earlier, the company had filed its IPO papers with the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) in September 2019 and had obtained the markets regulator approval in November 2019, to float the initial share sale but the company did not go ahead with the launch.

Opening of PWD Rest Houses for tourists yields sharp increase in revenue: Kerala Minister

Kerala Government's decision to turn the Rest Houses under the Public Works Department (PWD) into the state's largest hospitality network by opening up them for the tourists and the public has yielded a steep increase of 54 per cent in revenue from these public assets since March last year.

According to Minister for Public Works and Tourism P A Mohamed Riyas, income from nine rest houses rose to INR 6.32 crore after the government rebranded the facility as People's Rest House in November 2021. A total of 1.08 lakh bookings were recorded by the rest houses after making them easily accessible to tourists and the public by introducing an online booking system and regulation of check-in and check-out timings, which marks an increase of 57 per cent, the Minister said.

Burger chain McDonald's to lay off hundreds of corporate employees: Source



The number of corporate employees McDonald's Corp plans to lay off this week will tally in the "hundreds," a source familiar with the burger chain's thinking said, as the company moves forward with a previously announced restructuring.

The fast-food company is closing its offices "out of respect," and to "provide dignity, confidentiality, and comfort to our colleagues," said the source, which was not authorized to speak to the media.

"It used to be that folks would be called into a conference room with the windows papered over and then have to walk back to their desk to collect their personal belongings and leave with their head down," the source said.
